Details of PPI Opportunity:

Tasks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To attend meetings, likely to take place every 1-2 months to review and discuss research ideas and findings. Meetings will usually be online. To read and provide verbal and written feedback on documents about studies e.g.. patient information sheets or project reports. Some of these can be quite technical. To suggest changes or improvements to the research.
Payment	Recognition payment offered of £27.50 per hour by bank transfer or electronic vouchers. Other expenses may be covered if needed, e.g., travel for an in-person meeting.
Support	<p>You will be provided with support by the PPIE Coordinator and research team throughout and we will check what accessibility needs or preferred ways of working you might have and how best to support before you join.</p> <p>We recognise that contributing to research on pregnancy loss can be difficult or upsetting.
