Who Cannot Take Part

To keep our study results accurate, you won't be eligible if:

- You have personally experienced a neurological disorder, or you have provided close caregiving for someone with one. Having a relative who has had a stroke does not exclude you.
- You have formal or professional training in AI, data science, or search engine optimisation.
- You have formal or professional training in healthcare, rehabilitation, nursing, allied health, or medical education.
- You use large language models (e.g., ChatGPT, Claude) more than twice per week.
