

## Can you help improve how medicines are used in everyday care? Join the Patient and Public Involvement team for IMAB-Qi

We are looking for one additional Patient and Public Involvement (PPI) member aged 16 or over to join our small, friendly team.

**IMAB-Qi** (Identification of Medication Adherence Barriers Questionnaire Intervention) is a five-year NIHR-funded national study focused on improving how people are supported to take medicines as prescribed. It aims to do this through more personalised and effective medication reviews in general practice.

While the study measures blood pressure as a key clinical outcome, the intervention can be used across a diverse range of health conditions and populations.

### About you and the role

We are keen to hear from people who can bring **broader community perspectives** to the programme, especially voices that reflect, represent or have strong links with communities that are often **under-represented** in research. This includes individuals from **Chinese and wider Asian backgrounds**, where cultural perspectives and experiences may influence how medicines are understood, discussed and used in practice.

PPI members work closely with the research team and contribute to a range of activities, such as reviewing study materials, advising on inclusive approaches and helping shape how IMAB-Qi is communicated to different audiences. Experience of contributing views or feedback to health research or service improvement would be helpful but is not essential.

**Time commitment:** flexible involvement, typically through monthly online meetings and occasional requests for input.

**Payment:** £27.50 per hour for agreed activities.
