

## Have you, or are you a carer for someone who has experienced any of the following?



- COPD
- Lung Cancer
- Idiopathic Pulmonary Fibrosis (IPF)
- Asthma and use either a Corticosteroid inhaler (steroid inhaler), or a dry powder inhaler
- Asthma and you have changed to a different type of treatment at least once.
- Interstitial lung disease
- Been hospitalised in the past with pneumonitis or pneumonia

### Are you willing to tell us about your healthcare experiences?

A patient's perspective of a condition is often very different to a scientist's. By talking to University Masters students who are studying the immune system, you can help them to understand the impact that their research could have on people's lives. You could also help them learn how to explain their research to a public audience.

### Who are we looking for and what do we need you to do?

We are looking for patients/members of the public who would be happy to:

- Talk about their experiences of the condition above to a small group of students (1-2).
- Listen to students explaining their research and tell them if you don't understand what they are telling you. (Please note that that this is laboratory-based research and may take many years before it has an impact on patient care)
